"I took a call from one of Amanda S.'s clients, and my heart just melted. They stated that she was welcoming and open and immediately met them at their level. She joked with them, and they stated they 'have never felt more seen and heard.'"

Staff attended over 35 backto-school events in our 8county service area. Kudos to the entire staff for assisting our Prevention Team. "It is so wonderful to work with such an amazing group of superheroes." A transportation company stopped by the office, stating that they were here to pick up a client. Katie had a gut check - told him to wait - and alerted the Director. It was discovered that the company had been notified through Medicaid, but other transportation had already been arranged. High praise to Katie for trusting her gut and prioritizing client privacy and safety.
